We need to find a way to connect what we are doing to measurable results, in order fulfill the third idea better. However, we also need to figure out how to find a way to show results of skills and dispositions. It is difficult to have measurable results for those areas of student learning.

We discussed the Foothill Trust Land Plan for 2017-2018. There was significant discussion about the wording for the first goal. The discussion focused around making sure that the 10 percent who are not meeting or exceeding grade-level benchmarks are still progressing. Phrasing about this was agreed upon and added to the goal. Emily moved to approve the Trust Land Plan and Jill seconded it. The plan was approved by unanimous vote.
