Fall 2019 Extracurricular Classes

We have so many amazing after school classes to offer this Fall! Here's some important information about signing up for classes:

- All classes will be held weekly from November 5th until December 5th from 3:35-4:20pm. No classes will be held the week of Thanksgiving.
- Students **MUST** be picked up on time. If a student is picked up late, he/she will be unable to attend the rest of the sessions and will be invited to sign up again during the next round of classes. In these cases, refunds will not be issued.
- Only the student(s) registered will be able to attend each class. Younger/older siblings (not in the class) will not be allowed to attend or wait in the hall or lobby. There is not supervision for siblings.
- Starting at 4:00pm today, you can register at www.grovecrest.alpineschools.org.
- **If experiencing problems, try using a different internet browser or a computer instead of a cell phone.
- Classes are \$10 each and fill up quickly. You **MUST** first reserve your student's spot online. Then, return the completed blue form (on the back) and pay for the class within two school days. If you don't, the spot may be given to another student. You can pay with cash, check (payable to Grovecrest Elementary), or by calling or coming in to the office to pay with a credit card.
