Welcome to first grade! We are excited to meet your children and begin our fun year of learning.

Curriculum

All subjects will be taught using the Utah State Core Standards. These can be found at www.uen.org/core. We will teach all of the standards. We have identified essential standards in language arts and math that we will work to ensure that every child masters during first grade. These are:

Language Arts	Math
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of key details in a text. I can identify the main topic and key details of a paragraph. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can identify features of print. I can count syllables in words. I can read short and long vowel words. I can read words with consonant blends. I can read consonant digraphs (sh, ch, wh, th). I can read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension. I can determine the meaning of words using strategies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write opinion and narrative pieces. I can use capital, punctuation and grade-level spelling. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write and speak with proper sentences and grammar. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can count to 120, starting at any number. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write numbers 1-120. I can add and subtract within 20, fluently within 10. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use addition and subtraction strategies. I can explain the relationship between + and -. I can identify place value and values of tens and ones. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can add two-digit #s and one-digit #s. I can add two-digit #s and a multiple of ten. I can tell and write time to the hour and half-hour. I can divide circles and rectangles into halves/fourths.

Homework

Students should read at least 20 minutes per day at home. We will be participating in our school's home reading program.

In October, we will begin Math Wizard. Students will bring home math facts to practice adding and subtracting fluently. More information will be coming.
