Celebrations:

- Introduction of SCC Council - Each member introduced herself.
- Summer Collaborations – did not address

Other Business:

- Budget for 2018-2019 year is \$75,080
- SCC Training – Sharon Faragher handed out descriptions of each person's responsibilities in SCC as well as information and schedules of training opportunities for SCC members.
- Norms - Reviewed Norms and goals. All members are happy with them and see no need for a motion to change. Reviewed the importance of setting attainable goals that still encourage teachers and students to reach for higher achievement. Sharon Faragher and Principal Park assured committee that OES teachers all reach for benchmark and never for minimum improvement. Mrs. Park also explained Double Dose and Aide schedules.

Proposals:

- **Utah Literacy Conference** is October 25-26, 2018 in Midway, UT. The cost is \$269 per teacher. Hotel cost is \$129. Mrs Park didn't think a hotel would be necessary and Dr Chilcoat concurred. Mrs Park explained the benefits of the conference and recommended 2-4 upper grade teachers attend. The cost for 4 teachers would be \$1076. Mrs Park recommended \$ for teachers to purchase books that may be beneficial.

Katie Stiles proposed SCC spend up to \$1200 for 4 teachers to attend and purchase books.

Vote in favor was unanimous

Sharon Faragher asked to amend the proposal to include up to \$800 for subs

Katie Stiles made a motion to amend the amount to \$2000

Dr Chilcoat – 2nd

Vote in favor was unanimous

- **Math Conference** – Oct 12-13 at Draper Park Middle School Draper, UT
\$80 per person. Friday night keynote speaker, Saturday morning training 8am-11am.

Kristen Allen motioned for up to \$350 spent for 3 teachers to attend and \$110 to purchase books.

Vote in favor was unanimous

- **2nd Grade Collaboration –**

Miss Conover requested sub pay for a collaboration day for the 1st grade team so they can work on assessments. 2 of the teachers are new teachers and Miss Conover has just moved to 2nd grade.

Kristen Allen made a motion for SCC to pay up to \$300 for 3 subs for the 1st grade team for a collaboration day.

- **Other Grades Collaborations**

- a. Mrs Giles asked for SCC to pay for subs for 1 day of collaboration for the 1st grade team. This led to a discussion on what is done during collaboration. Mrs Giles said the 1st grade team is working together to identify students who need extra help and how to provide the needed help. She asked for subs for 4 teachers for one day - \$400

Katie Stiles made a motion to pay up to \$400 for subs for 2nd grade team

Cindy Chilcoat – 2nd

Vote in favor was unanimous

- b. 3rd grade also asked for \$ for subs for collaboration

Jalanne Collins motioned for SCC to pay up to \$300 for subs for 3rd grade collaboration

- **Computer Programs (Define STEM, Reflex Math, IXL)**

- a. **Define Stem** was explained by Mrs Park. The course would be for our A.L.L. teachers. This course will help teachers integrate STEM tasks for deeper learning. A.L.L. teachers would then be in charge of the Professional Development day in October and share with all OES teachers.

Andrea Park made a motion for SCC to pay \$1295 for Define STEM

Angie Reynolds – 2nd

Vote in favor was unanimous

- b. **Reflex Math** was used by 6th grade last year and they would like it again. The cost for 6th grade would be \$4795 (\$35 per student x 137 students) Cost for entire school is \$3295.

- c. **IXL**, explained by Sharon Faragher, is a program that students can use at home during the school year and in the summer. It covers a variety of subjects. When the student gives a wrong answer—it gives an explanation.

Angie Reynold motioned that SCC pay up to \$9000 for computer programs - Reflex Math and IXL

Laura Giles 2nd

Vote in favor was unanimous.

- **Tech Training for Teachers**

Janice Smith would like to provide after school classes for faculty on tech training such as Google Classroom and Lucidchart.

Kristen Allen motioned that SCC pay up to \$2500 for Janice Smith to provide classes.
