Strategies for Teaching Basic Skills at Home

Come learn some simple techniques to help students who need a little extra "one-on-one" to learn basic academic skills at school or at home. We will focus on three interventions:

- 1) **Task analysis** - breaking tasks down into smaller, more manageable parts to detect where the breakdown is occurring,
- 2) **I do, we do, you do** - a modeling method, and
- 3) **Discrete trial training** - a method for providing multiple repetitions of a skill/concept to enhance learning of more abstract or "memorized" concepts such as ABCs, basic math facts, etc.

This class is designed for parents of students in younger elementary grades and preschool, but the concepts can be applied with older students as well.
