Alpine School District – Full-Day Kindergarten

What is the Schedule?

Full-Day Kindergarten will follow the attendance calendar and traditional elementary hours of 1st-6th grade.

Who Qualifies for Full-Day Kindergarten?

Children need to be 5 years of age before September 1st of the year in which admission is sought (meaning the child has to be 5 on or before Sept 1st).

What Will My Child Learn?

Students will be instructed in literacy, math, science, and social skills, through fun, engaging, and age appropriate learning experiences. They will have access to library time. Students will also participate in specialty areas such as music, art, computers, and PE.

How Will Full-Day Kindergarten Differ from Half-Day Kindergarten?

All students in Alpine School District will be taught the USBE standards for kindergarten. Students in full-day kindergarten will have extended learning experiences that allow for more in-depth exploration. The additional instructional time allows for more individualized groupings for students to master the early learning skills that will lay the foundation for their future success.

What Will Lunch Be Like?

School lunch will be offered to Kindergarten students the same as 1st-6th grade students.

Is Half-Day Kindergarten Still An Option?
